Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our teaching of PSHE curriculum for this half term, the children will be learning about 'Respectful Relationships' and 'Being Safe'. They have already learnt about making choices and have begun to talk about the difference from when they were small to now.

In the next stage of the topic, classes will be learning about the physical differences between boys and girls. One of the lessons will include the naming of body parts. Included within this lesson will be the term 'private' body parts and as a class we shall be using the words 'penis' and 'vagina' when naming these areas of the body. This is taken from guidance from the NSPCC, with regards to keeping children safe. It is also important that we remain consistent with the terminology we use so we do not confuse our children.
