DETERMINED DEERS


In the Deers this term we have been learning about dinosaurs and the ice age. In English we have been developing our reading, writing and communication skills around this topic. We have had fun doing our dinosaurs write dance. In Maths we have been using dinosaurs and ice age animals to develop our counting skills and identifying size.

In Science and History we have been about fossils learning all through exploration and we also have been learning about extinct animals from the ice age. In Design and Technology, we made mammoth tusks and fossils using salt dough. In RE we learned about Chinese New Year and Valentines and in PSHE we discussed bullying and kind and unkind behaviour. In physical development we did lots of OT and sensory circuit work and did gymnastics where we learned to move around like different dinosaurs



REMARKABLE RABBITS

This term in the Rabbits for communication and language we have been reading a sensory story called "The rainbow fish".



The children have enjoyed exploring different objects linked to the story, as well as engaging in under the sea water play.



The children have also been working on their transition skills and have become so much more confident travelling to various places around the school!





SUPER SQUIRRELS AUGMENTED REALITY

Over the past few weeks, the Squirrels have been looking at size! Long and short and Tall and short.

One of the things we have really enjoyed is using Augmented Reality to see what life-sized animals would look like in our classroom!

Hedgehogs have had yet another fun packed half term full of smiles and fun learning.

They have had the chance to be archaeologists, and dug for fossils and dinosaur bones, as well as working hard with their number work finding one more and one less. They have enjoyed celebrating Chinese New Year by making spring rolls, stir-fried noodles and fried rice - which all tasted delicious!

The visit from Active Sport enabled all of the children to take part in activities such as Archery, Darts, Nerf Guns and Boxing Punch Pads!

We have also started a weekly walk to the local shop, which has been a huge success, to primarily support their maths work on money.

Continuing from the progress made in the Autumn term, Hedgehogs are either having weekly swimming lessons, this term, or hydrotherapy sessions.

We are all very much looking forward to next half term to build on the progress made so far this year.
